What is Social Value?

Social value is defined through the Public Services (Social Value) Act (2013) which requires organisations and their suppliers to look beyond the financial cost of a contract to consider how the services they commission and procure can improve the economic, social, and environmental wellbeing of an area.

The Alliance is bringing this type of added value to voluntary and community organisations, from the generosity of organisations offering a range of services, (pre-employment support, printing, fund writing, building materials and lots more) for public benefit.

This offer is made as part of Sunderland City Council's pledge to use its contracts with external companies to enable suppliers to provide charitable donations to local communities.

What Next?

If you think this could be you, and would like to apply, you will need to complete and return our short application form, describing how you would use the offer and what difference it will make to both your organisation and your community. After the deadline date, a panel will meet to choose the winning organisation. Some organisations may be contacted by the company prior to the decision-making panel to discuss the feasibility and size of the project, or for further information.
